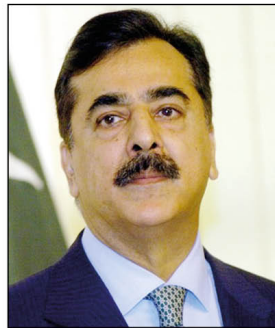
Gilani launches internship programme to promote democratic, legislative awareness
