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## **ABSTRACT**

Oil and Gas Development Company Limited is exploration and Production Company of Pakistan. Since its incorporation, OGDCL has proved itself a leading E&P Company in the country. The major departments of OGDCL are HR Department, Finance Department, Production and Exploration department and supply Chain Management department. Each of the above-mentioned department has its own role; however, the ultimate goal of all the departments to take necessary efforts to achieve the common goal of the organization i.e. to be a leading company in fields of exploration and production in the region. The focus of our project is based on the Supply Chain Management Department of Oil and Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL). Supply Chain Management is an important and large department. The department is headed by Executive Director (Services) and has two main wings i.e. Procurement Department headed by General Manager (SCM) and Materials Management Department headed by General Manager (Materials). We have also identified some problem in their operation and have also given recommendations which will be helpful to overcome their issues & problems.

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
