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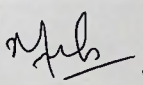
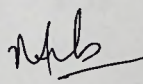
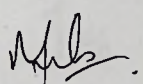

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ABSTRACT

In this research, the focus was mainly on the impact of heuristic style of teaching. An effort has been made to know the real impact of heuristic methods used in teaching.
